

Ingredients

Feeding oatmeal, yeast culture, dried yeast (Saccharomyces cerevisiae) fermentation solubles, cane molasses, DL-methionine, zinc methionine, D-biotin, along with sorbic acid, propionic acid and ethoxyquin as preservatives.

Function and Use

Biotime is truly a unique nutrition supplement for the hooves and coats of horses. Since poor-quality hooves and rough, dry hair coats can result from several nutrient deficiencies and/or the diminished ability to metabolize these nutrients, Biotime takes a multi-nutrient approach toward the prevention of these conditions.

The wide range of nutrients included in Biotime are supplied in a very palatable oatmeal- and molasses-based pellet, which can easily be top-dressed over your horse's feed or fed alone. The small scoop enclosed in each package of Biotime holds approximately a 1-oz. feeding, which is recommended for horses with poor-quality hooves and/or dry, rough hair coats.

While positive results have been reported much earlier, several weeks or even months of supplementation may be necessary before the full benefits of Biotime can be seen in the horse.
