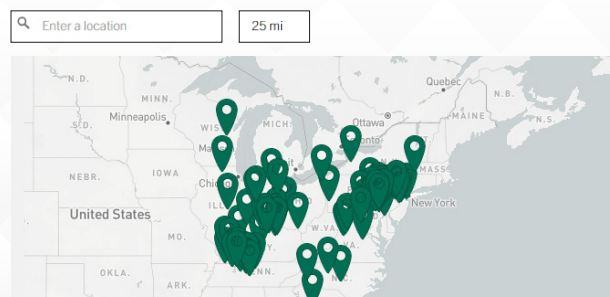

Function

The unique formulation of McCauley's Hydrolyte encourages drinking and facilitates rehydration. Equine sweat is hypertonic, meaning the level of electrolytes in a horse's sweat is greater than the level in its blood. As a result, even if horses are dehydrated, they may lack the desire to drink.

When added to drinking water, Hydrolyte provides a more consistent taste and smell to different water sources. This is useful when horses are temporarily relocated (e.g., during shows or at events, etc.).
